- Employment opportunities through a Recruitment Management System (RMS).



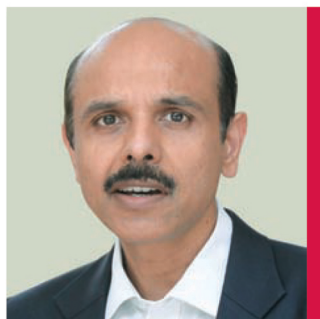
TSSC- GOVERNING BODY

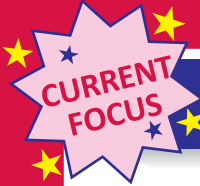
